ERASMUS MUNDUS DUNIA BEAM - WHAT IS IT?

Dunia Beam Project is an ERASMUS MUNDUS Action 2 programme financed by the European Commission and coordinated by the University of Pavia. Dunia Beam Project is a programme that contributes to the strengthening cooperation among European Higher Education Institutions and Middle-East Institutions, specifically with Jordan, Lebanon, Palestine and Syria, by facilitating the mobility of students, researchers and academic and administrative staff through a scholarships scheme, curriculum development of the individuals, the transfer of know-how in international mobility and the exchange of best practices.

WHO ARE THE BENEFICIARIES?

- Students: Bachelor Degree, Master Degree, PhD or Post-doc.
- Academic and administrative staff.



WHAT KIND OF SCHOLARSHIPS?

Scholars are divided into three categories, called target groups, depending on their characteristics. In particular, the periods of individual mobility are offered to:

- Students and staff registered in one of the higher education institutions member of the partnership (Target group 1)
- Nationals of the third countries concerned and Europeans registered in a higher education institution not included in the partnership (Target group 2)
- Nationals of third countries who are in a situation of particular vulnerability, due to physical disability or for political or economic reasons (Target group 3)

COMPOSITION OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The amount of the scholarships varies for different target groups and takes into account the following parameters:

- Monthly Allowance
- Insurance
- Participation costs paid by host university (if applicable)

LEVEL OF MOBILITY	DURATION	MONTHLY ALLOWANCE
Undergraduate	6 - 10 - 36 months	1,000€
Graduate	10 - 24 months	1,000€
PhD	10 - 36 months	1,500€
Post-Doc	10 months	1,800€
Staff	1 month	2,500€
